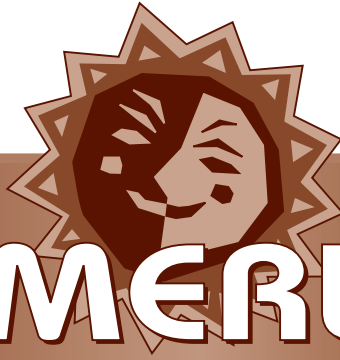

Community Watch – Since we are all neighbors, the concept of neighborhood watch becomes a little more expansive. If you see a problem or issue anywhere in Summerlin please take the time to report it. 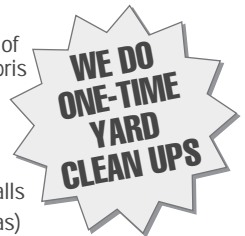

- 1 cup dried cranberries
- 2 tablespoons minced garlic
- 1 tablespoon minced fresh sage
- 1 tablespoon minced fresh thyme
- 3 cups hot chicken stock
- Salt and freshly ground black pepper

Method:

Preheat oven to 375 degrees F. Melt butter and sweat the vegetables until tender. Combine all items, including cornbread, in a large casserole dish and cook covered with aluminum foil for 30 minutes. Remove foil and cook for additional 20 – 25 minutes or until the top is crispy and golden brown.

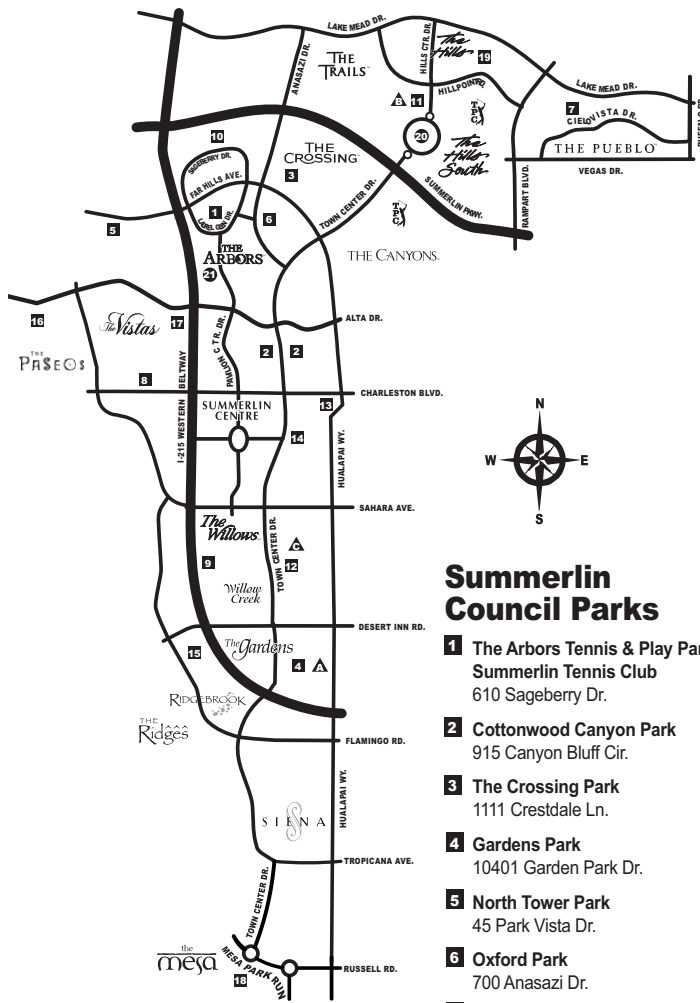

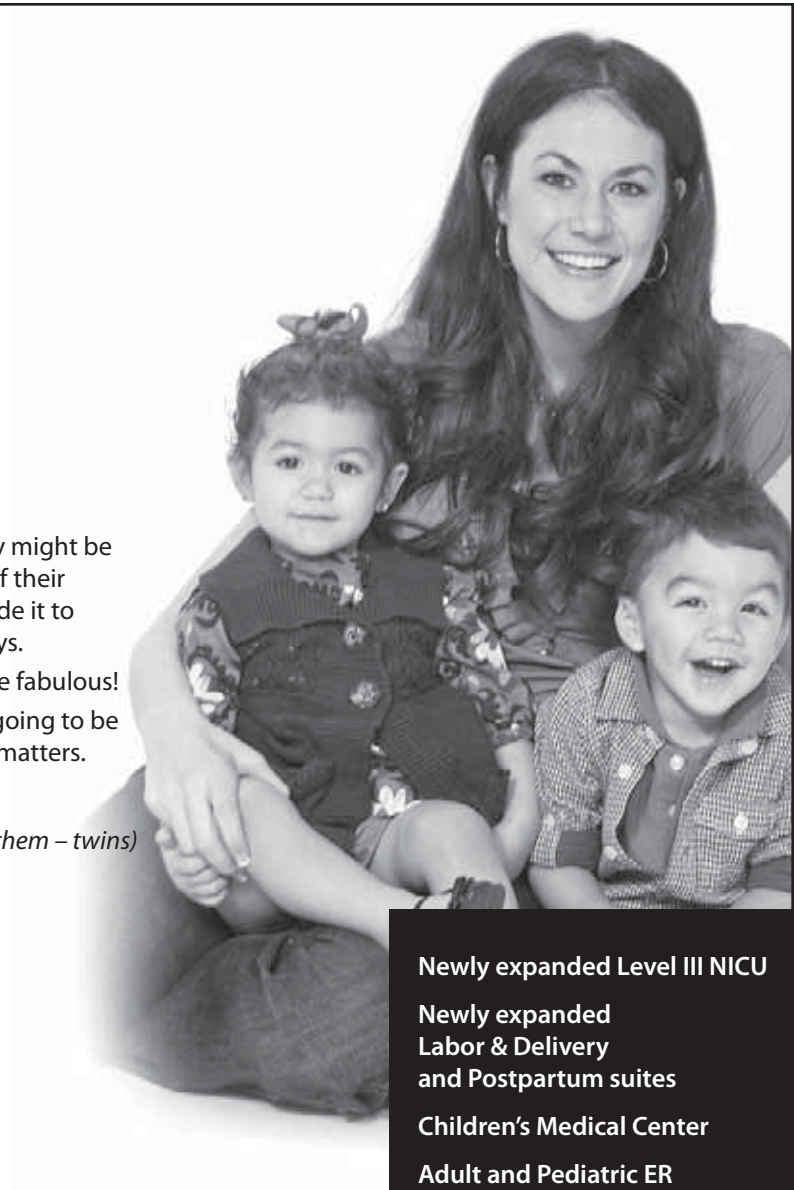
