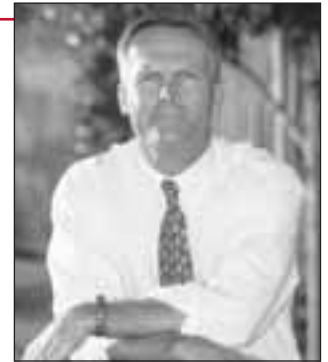

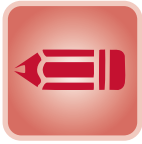

News From The West

SUMMERLIN WEST HOLDS ANNUAL MEETING

The Summerlin West Community Association held its Ninth Annual Meeting on November 3rd at the Wilhows Community Center. A quorum was not met; however, Members present conducted the business authorized under NRS 116 when a quorum is not present, including the approval of the 2010 Annual Meeting Minutes.

The Howard Hughes Corporation exercised its rights to appoint the Board of Directors and appointed Peggy Chandler, Robert Carroll and Nikki Liesse MCartin to serve in that capacity. As of 9/30/11 there were 5,720 units annexed into the Association, with 4,515 of those units owned by persons other than the builders. The first homeowner will be elected to the board when 7,500 units are owned by persons other than builders.

In accordance with NRS 116.31151, the 2012 Operating and Reserve Budgets were not rejected by a majority of the units' owners and therefore are considered ratified. **The monthly assessment will remain at \$39 per month.**

Prior to the business portion of the Member meeting, The Howard Hughes Corporation gave an update of future development in Summerlin. At the end of the business meeting there was a period of open discussion and an opportunity for Members to ask questions regarding future development and Association issues. ❄️

Following is the resolution adopted by Summerlin West regarding holiday decorations:

SUMMERLIN WEST COMMUNITY ASSOCIATION - RESOLUTION - HOLIDAY DECORATIONS

WHEREAS, the Bylaws for the Summerlin West Community Association, Article III, Section C, 3.16 and 3.17 (f), provide the Board of Directors power and duty to adopt and promulgate reasonable rules and restrictions for the Association, and

WHEREAS, there is a need to establish guidelines concerning the display of holiday decorations,

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Directors of the Summerlin West Community Association has established the following policy:

- Holiday decorations may be displayed for 30 days prior to the holiday.
- Holiday decorations must be removed within 30 days following the holiday.

The Summerlin Council is encouraging Summerlin residents to participate in the spirit of holiday giving by collecting goods for the Las Vegas Rescue Mission. Household items, canned goods, clothing and unwrapped toys will be received at each of Summerlin's community centers, located in The Gardens, The Trails and The Willows villages. The Las Vegas Rescue Mission currently houses up to 152 men in their residential program, as well as 45 women and children in the Shelter of Hope. Beyond the residential programs, The Rescue Mission provides emer-

gency shelter from the harsh Las Vegas climate for an additional 60 men each night.

The focus of the Rescue Mission is to touch as many lives as possible in an active and tangible way. Residents can attend the Chapel Service held every evening, as well as listen to a special message of hope presented by the resident pastor.

The Rescue Mission also provides meals, clothing, household items and life-skills counseling for those who are in need. They don't simply provide a hand-out, but a hand-up for those who are willing to accept an opportunity to



get back on their feet.
