POOL RULES AND REGULATIONS

ADMITTANCE

A Summerlin Resident Card with season pass sticker and/or daily visit receipt must be presented by each resident upon arrival at pool entrance. Guests are limited to one (1) per resident per visit and only will be admitted when accompanied by a resident who must accept responsibility for the actions of their guests. Resident and guest visits may be purchased online at summerlink.com/community/pools/.

SUPERVISION REQUIREMENT

Adults with minor children: To assure proper supervision, The Summerlin Council requires a minimum of one adult (sixteen years of age and older) per four children under ten years of age. Adults should be within arms length if any child is wearing a floatation device.

POOL RULES

- All swimmers must shower prior to entering the pool water
- Do not swim with open wounds or sores, if you are ill with diarrhea or have had diarrhea within the past two weeks
- The use of personal floatation devices, rafts and water toys is subject to the approval of the lifeguards. The responsible adult must be within arm's length of each child wearing a flotation device
- No rough play allowed including dunking, pushing, splashing and cannonballing
- Intentional hyperventilation or extended breath holding activities are dangerous and prohibited
- Diaper changing on the deck is prohibited
- Do not pollute, urinate or defecate in the pool water
- Do not swallow or spit pool water
- Only sunscreen and tanning lotions allowed. No oils

FACILITY RULES

- Unsafe or offensive conduct is prohibited. Persons using obscene or profane language will be asked to leave
- Only battery operated radios with head phones are allowed within the pool enclosure
- The use of pool toys, floats, etc., is subject to the approval of the lifeguards
- The use of personal floatation devices are subject to the approval of the lifeguards and are not a substitute for parental supervision

PLEASE NOTE:

- Suitable swim apparel is required in the pool area
- Bathers must wear appropriate attire that is designed and intended for use as swimwear. Street clothing such as cotton fabrics, basketball shorts, denim, shoes and socks are not permitted
- Children under 2 ½ years must wear little swimmer pants or plastic pants before entering the pool
- No animals are permitted in the pool or on the deck and surrounding areas except for service animals
- No smoking or vaping within the pool or on the deck and surrounding areas
- No alcohol allowed
- No glass items allowed
- Food is allowed in designated areas only

The pool is governed by state and local laws.
In the event of any conflict between such laws and these rules,
the provisions of such laws shall control to the extent they are most restrictive.

Management may ask any person in violation of the rules and regulations
to leave the pool area. All rules are subject to change
without prior notice if conditions so require.
