PARADE EVENT MARKING AND SAFETY GUIDELINES

The Summerlin Council is committed to providing a safe and enjoyable environment for Patriotic Parade attendees. To help ensure the best parade experience, please review the following parade event marking and safety guidelines prior to a parade day:

- To increase equal access to the Patriotic Parade, parade attendees may set up their viewing area along the parade route beginning at 7 a.m. the day preceding the event.
- Personal items placed prior to this time will be removed and donated.

 Use of duct tape, chalk and paint to mark a parade viewing area along the parade route
- Only pop-up canopy or shade type tents no larger than 10' x 10' may be placed along the parade route. No fully enclosed tents with side panels are allowed.
- Only portable outdoor recreation furniture is permitted along the parade route. No household furniture or ladders are allowed.
- Any items blocking the right of way along sidewalks, crosswalks or roadways will be
- Any car parked along the parade route will be towed. Please be courteous and remove all trash, debris and personal items when leaving
- The Summerlin Council and Summerlin North Community Association assume no responsibility for personal items left unattended along the parade route.

Please note: Road closures on parade day begin before 3 a.m. and continue until approximately 12 p.m. The community is encouraged to plan ahead accordingly and minimize vehicular travel during this time.

More Places to Wander





Roseman University Unveils Ambitious Expansion Plans for Summerlin[®] Campus

Roseman University of Health Sciences, located between Town Center Drive, Hualapai Way and the 215 Beltway, is set to embark on an ambitious expansion of its campus in Summerlin, marking a significant milestone in its mission to enhance healthcare education and research in Nevada. This expansion promises to deliver substantial economic benefits to the Summerlin community and Southern Nevada, reinforcing the university's position as a premier institution for health sciences.

The existing campus in Summerlin spans 14 acres and includes three buildings with a combined area of 431,425 square feet. The campus currently accommodates 1,144 surface and garage parking spaces and serves multiple functions, including academic and administrative operations, a dental clinic, the Cure 4 The Kids Foundation, and bioscience research, including Roseman University's Bioscience Collaborative, which engages life sciences companies in academic, research, and business partnerships. healthcare and research professionals. Operations at the university's Henderson campus will be consolidated into the expanded campus in Summerlin, which will become the central hub for the university's administration and academic programs within the Colleges of Medicine, Pharmacy, Nursing, Dental Medicine, and Graduate Studies, and provide space for additional academic programs to be added. The new facilities will feature cutting-edge classrooms, laboratories, and research spaces designed to foster an environment of innovation and academic excellence.

The expansion of the campus is anticipated to generate significant economic benefits for the entire region. The construction phase will create hundreds of jobs, providing a substantial boost to the local construction industry and associated sectors. The increased presence of students, faculty, researchers, support staff, and visitors will stimulate local businesses, including retail, dining, and housing. The new auditorium and retail spaces are expected to complement University activities and needs as well as service the community, and investment to the area.

Roseman University's expansion underscores its mission to advance healthcare education and research and represents a pivotal development in the institution's trajectory of growth, enhancing its capacity to make significant contributions to healthcare education and the broader community. Infrastructure Investments Keep **Southern Nevada's Drinking Water Flowing**

hether you live in the northwest Las Vegas Valley V or Henderson, the Las Vegas Valley Water District (LVVWD) and the Southern Nevada Water Authority (SNWA) are planning and building infrastructure facilities to continue providing safe, reliable service to meet the community's water needs for decades to come.

NEW RESERVOIRS IN THE NORTHWEST

Construction on several new reservoir and pumping station projects is currently underway by the LVVWD, including the Rome Reservoir and Pumping Station in the northwest valley.

The LVVWD is also working to complete the fivemillion-gallon Centennial Reservoir near Centennial Parkway and Fort Apache Road and the 10-million-gallon Cougar Reser-voir near Blue Diamond Road and Hualapai Way. These facilities will further enhance our community's storage and pumping needs.



BOLSTERING RELIABILITY IN HENDERSON

In the south valley, the Southern Nevada Water Authority (SNWA) is developing plans for the Horizon Lateral Program, which will boost system reliability by adding a dual feed for the area and protecting water delivery for nearly a million existing customers.

The SNWA is exploring two potential pipeline routes a preferred "south alignment" through mostly undeveloped areas, including tunneling under a portion of the Sloan Canyon National Conservation Area, and a "north alignment" through developed portions of Henderson.

No matter where you live in Southern Nevada, these and many other investments in capital improvements will help ensure safe and dependable drinking water is constantly flowing whenever you turn on the tap.
