

Chill Out Your Landscape Watering This Winter

Time to make the switch! Change your watering clock for the winter season. With cooler temperatures settling in, winter watering restrictions are in effect from November 1 through February 28. It's the perfect opportunity to save water when landscapes need less. Do your part to help protect our precious water supply!

During the winter season, sprinkler irrigation is limited to one assigned day per week; watering is prohibited on Sunday year-round.

The colder weather also benefits water-efficient plants and trees on drip irrigation systems, which can survive and even thrive when you water them just one day a week or less!

Avoid overwatering your landscape and keep your landscape healthy in the cold months by following these tips:

• Water during the mid-morning hours to avoid freezing and prevent ice from forming on lawns and sidewalks.



- Change the time on your irrigation clock to coincide with the end of Daylight-Saving Time on Sunday, November 3.
- Turn your irrigation clock off on rainy days.
- Follow the seasonal watering restrictions yearround to help you save up to \$300 annually on your water bills.
- Avoid costly fines! Watering on unassigned days or allowing water to flow off your property may result in a water-waste fee starting at \$80. So, chill out and don't waste water!



Goose Street. Look for Christmas Tree Recycling signage at both locations.

Valley-wide, there are more than 30 locations accepting trees. There is no cost to drop off trees, but all non-organic objects such as lights, wire, tinsel, ornaments, and nails, must be removed before dropping off trees. Artificial trees and real trees flocked with decorative chemical compounds cannot be recycled.

"Trees are chipped into organic mulch and used in public gardens and parks across the valley to help conserve soil moisture and keep plants healthy. Most importantly, recycled trees are kept out of our community's landfills and put to good use," said Ecklund.

Since the Christmas Tree Recycling committee started tracking trees in 2011, more than 300,000 trees have been diverted from the landfill, with a ten-year average of more than 16,000 trees each year. 
